

NOTICE OF ELECTION

CITY OF DENMARK

Notice is hereby given that a General Election for the Town of Denmark will be held on **Tuesday, February 9, 2021**. The purpose of this election will be to elect a Mayor and three (3) Council persons to serve a four (4) year term as required by law. The filing fee is \$50.00.

Citizens desiring to be candidates for the above listed offices must reside within the municipal limits of Denmark. All Candidates must file a Statement of Candidacy at the Denmark City Hall, 64 City Hall Street, Denmark SC, during business hours. **The filing period will open Thursday, December 17, 2020 at 12:00 noon and close Thursday, December 31, 2020 at 12:00 noon.**

Any person wishing to register to vote in the election must do so no later than **January 9, 2021**.

The Polls shall be open from 7:00 am until 7:00 pm. The Managers of Election shall see that each person offering to vote takes the oath that he/she is qualified to vote at this election according to the Constitution of this State and that he/she has not voted before in this election.

Voters who are blind, physically disabled or unable to read or write are entitled to assistance in casting his/her ballot. This assistance may be given by anyone the voter chooses except his/her employer, an agent of his/her employer or an officer or agent of his/her union. The Managers must be notified if assistance is needed.

Voters who are unable to enter their polling place due to physical handicap or are 65 years of age or older may vote in the vehicle in which they drove or were driven to the polls. When notified, the managers will help voters using the curbside voting provision.

Registered electors who cannot vote in person may be eligible to vote by absentee ballot. Persons wishing more information concerning absentee voting should contact the Bamberg County Board of Voter Registration and Elections at (803) 245-3028, ext. 2104

At 6:00 pm on Election Day, the examination of the absentee ballot return envelopes will be held at the, J. Carl Kearse Agricultural Building, 847 Calhoun Street, Bamberg, SC, 29003. On Thursday February 11, 2021, at 10:00 am, the County Board of Canvassers will hold a hearing to determine the validity of all provisional ballots cast in this election. This hearing will be held at the J. Carl Kearse Agricultural Building, 847 Calhoun Street, Bamberg, SC 29003.
